It has an independent entrance and its own garden, fenced off from the common areas with the traditional wood bar fencing in chestnut. It shares swimming pool together with houses Castagno and Ginepro. It s completely supplied with kitchen equipment (oven, fridge, freezer, kettle...), linen, towels (with weekly changes), tv. The swimming pools are fully supplied with umbrellas, sun loungers and cushions. You can also find some useful accessories as hair-dryer, umbrella, flashlight. There is a laundry shared by the apartments, with a washing machine and ironing facilities. There is also a game room for the guests with tv, video, ping pong table, board games and children's games.

The structure is the same as the other apartments but the accommodation is spread out over three floors. On the first floor there is a double room, a large landing with a single bed and a bathroom with shower. On the second floor there is a large attic room with three beds. Outside the private garden has a terrace with pergola.
