The shallow end is equipped with large steps and a gentle slope takes you to a depth of 1,60m. Thanks to salt water technology, the pool is sanitized without chemicals - Enjoy a carefree moment with your children spotting frogs in the pond and watching dragonflies hover across; your kids can run around safely, the pond and the little dead end forest road are fenced evening, catch up with family and friends as the meat on the barbecue sizzles and indulge in a glass or two of excellent Gaillac wine; enjoy the quiet life first hand!
